

## ATTENTION NURSING APPLICANTS!

Tennessee Technology Center has changed the entrance test required for admission into the Practical Nursing Program.

Starting in December, TTC-Harriman will administer the **Compass Exam**.

Passing scores on the previously used exam, the Nurse Entrance Test (NET), are still valid for two years; however, the student must be enrolled before the exam expires. This would include exams taken between May 3, 2008 and June 30, 2009.

Passing scores for the Compass Exam are 50 in Math and 80 in Reading. A calculator is built into the program.

The cost for the exam is \$15.00 and is **non-refundable**. No personal checks will be accepted. Students must pre-register and pay to reserve a test date. The exam takes approximately two hours to complete.

Early application is strongly encouraged!

Official ACT scores are accepted in lieu of the Compass if the student is 20 years of age or under, and scores must be 19 in all parts, Math, Reading and English. A 19 composite score is not acceptable.
